



ROLE TITLE: HASI Mental Health Support Worker

LOCATION: Kempsey

About the role

The Housing and Accommodation Support Initiative (HASI) Plus supports people with a severe mental illness to live and participate in the community in the way that they want to. Participants live in their own self-contained accommodation located on one site. You will be supporting participants to maintain their tenancy and providing safe and effective, recovery-oriented and trauma informed mental health support. There is a high focus on recovery values including hope, self-direction, empowerment, strength based and a peer support model.

You are supported by a Team Coordinator, Diversional Therapist and two Clinical Leads to provide wrap around inclusive holistic support.

Hours and location

Shifts on offer will be 30 hours per week with additional options to cover leave. You will be working shifts that support a 24 hour model so flexible availability is important. Staff in the program work in the community and at the site in Kempsey.
