About the role

In this role, you will get to work within a supportive team all working to improve the well-being of our participants. You will be guiding and supporting participants and help teach skills that bring meaningful and positive change. The successful B.well program has new funding to extend services to the Clarence region and we have new roles available based in Grafton.

B.well supports people aged 12+ with co-occurring mental health and substance misuse concerns. The counsellor supports them to connect with others, focus on their strengths, maintain a healthy lifestyle and lead a fulfilling life. This includes a range of support services including psycho-education, peer support groups, therapeutic programs, individual support, activities programs, life skills programs, early intervention, health programs and music therapy.

Hours and location

With this role, you can enjoy the freedom of a hybrid working environment. Staff in this program will work face to face in the community or an office environment based in Gurehlgam. You can also work from home a few days a week and make use of video conferencing. There are two roles available. One is 35 hours per week and the other is 25 hours per week. There is no weekend work. Instead, they operate on weekdays during general office hours and hours can be worked flexibly

1. **Qualifications:** Diploma qualifications or above in Counselling, AOD, Social Work, Psychology, mental health or Community Services.
2. **Licences and checks:** A current and valid Driver's Licence, a current COVID vaccination, satisfactory current Criminal Record Check and Working with Children Check

3. Demonstrated experience working in a recovery orientated mental health environment coordinating care for persons with complex support needs
4. Proven experience in undertaking complex negotiations, resolving conflict, building partnerships and addressing resistance.
5. Experience in delivering one on one counselling and group facilitation
6. Demonstrated proficiency using the Microsoft suite, a variety of databases and video conferencing applications.
