ROLE TITLE: Senior Clinician: Safe Haven Program

LOCATION: Woodburn and Lismore

About the role

About the role: As a Senior Clinician in our Safe Haven Program, you will get to provide immediate trauma-informed and person-centred care to participants. You will also support a team comprising a clinician, case worker and peer worker and manage day to day operational needs. We have opportunities available in Woodburn and Lismore.

The Buttery's Safe Havens are based in Lismore, Woodburn, Mullumbimby and Murwillumbah and open 9.00am – 3.30pm, Mon – Fri. They provide a safe space for the community to walk in and connect with a team of people in a comfortable and approachable environment. To ensure they receive follow-up support, participants will be offered information or a link with psychological, psychosocial and other community supports, depending on their needs.

Hours and location: The role is 35 hours per week with time for paperwork and training when havens are not open to the public. Primarily based in Woodburn, working from the Lismore Safe Haven may be required at times.

The role is funded to June 2025.

A Senior Clinician role based in Lismore is also available till end Dec 2024 (with possibility for extension)

About you: Selection Criteria to be addressed

Qualifications and Checks

1. Tertiary qualification at university level in Counselling, Nursing, Social Work or Psychology and current registration with peak body (eg. ACA, PACFA, AASW or AHPRA).
2. Current Driver's Licence and willingness to travel to support other Havens. Satisfactory Criminal Record Check, Working with Children Check, COVID vaccination and First Aid certificate

3. Demonstrated experience in delivery of mental health and/or suicide prevention support services in a community setting
4. Experience managing staff in a small team environment
5. Demonstrated experience in undertaking risk assessments and managing crisis situations
6. Experience in providing counselling and case management support to individuals from a trauma-informed approach.
7. Familiarity with a range of referral services across the local community
8. Demonstrated proficiency using the Microsoft suite and a variety of databases.
