Join Our Safe Haven Team as a Clinician and make a profound impact in the lives of those in distress. You'll have the opportunity to provide trauma-informed and person-centred care in a supportive drop-in service. Your small team in each haven has a Senior Clinician, Clinician, Case Worker and Peer Worker. You will also get to assist the Senior Clinician to support caseworkers and peer workers

Hours and location

Family friendly hours: There is no weekend work. Work 30 hours a week, Monday to Friday, from 9:00am to 3:30pm for 30 mins for lunch.

Dedicated debriefing time: From 3:00pm to 3:30pm, the Haven is closed, giving you valuable time for debriefing and note-taking.

Beautiful location: This position is based in Woodburn and flexibility to occasionally cover staff leave in other havens (Lismore, Murwillumbah and Mullumbimby) is part of the role.

About you: Selection Criteria

- 1. Tertiary qualification at university level in Counselling, Nursing, Social Work or Psychology and registered with Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) or Australian Association of Social Workers (AASW).
- 2. Licences and checks: A current and valid Driver's Licence, satisfactory current Criminal Record Check and Working with Children Check prior to commencement.
- Demonstrated experience in delivery of mental health and/or suicide prevention support services in a community setting.
- 4. Demonstrated experience in undertaking risk assessments and managing crisis situations.
- 5. Experience in providing counselling and support to individuals from a trauma-informed approach.
- 6. Demonstrated experience providing case management support for persons with complex support needs
- 7. Familiarity with a range of local referral services
- Availability to work from 9.00-3.30 from Monday to Friday
