About the role

Join Our Safe Haven Team as a Senior Clinician and make a profound impact in the lives of those in distress. You'll have the opportunity to provide trauma-informed and person-centred care in a supportive drop-in service. Each haven has a small team consisting of a Senior Clinician, Clinician, Case Worker and Peer Worker. You will be supporting your staff and managing day to day operational needs.

Family friendly hours: There is no weekend work. Work 35 hours a week, Monday to Friday. Havens are open from 9:00am to 3:00pm.

Dedicated debriefing time: From 3:00pm to 3:30pm, the Haven is closed, giving you and your staff valuable time for debriefing and note-taking.

Hybrid options: While you need to be onsite to support your staff from 9.00-3.30, your other hours can be worked from home.

Beautiful location: This position is based in Murwillumbah and flexibility to occasionally cover staff leave in other havens (Lismore, Woodburn and Mullumbimby) is part of the role.

The role is funded until 30th December 2025.

- Demonstrated experience in delivery of mental health and/or suicide prevention support services in a community setting.
