

**ROLE TITLE: AOD Case Worker Buttery Community Outreach Youth (BCOY)** 

**LOCATION: Byron Bay** 

### About the role

As a Case Worker in our Community Outreach Youth program, you get to actively facilitate improved wellbeing for young people. The program exists to: improve young people's capacity to manage their lives more effectively and reduce the problems associated with Alcohol and Other Drugs (AOD) use.

You will get to provide a range of evidence-based treatment and harm minimisation strategies to meet the needs of young people, their families and the local community. The target group is young people aged 10-19 from Coffs Harbour to Tweed. Travel to Acmena Youth Justice Centre in Grafton will be required. The role is funded until 30th June 2026 with potential for extension.

Hours and location: The position offers 27 hours per week, which can be worked flexibly over four or five days, with no weekend work required. Based in Byron, the role involves working in Acmena Youth Justice Centre in Grafton, schools and community services across the region. This role allows for both remote work and community engagement, providing opportunities to interact with participants and their families both online and in person. A pool car is available at the Binna Burra site for work-related travel.

## About you: Selection Criteria

- Diploma or higher tertiary qualification in areas such as AOD, social work, psychology, youth work or mental health
- Current Driver's Licence, a satisfactory Criminal Record Check and Working with Children Check

### Professional skills and experience

- 3. A minimum of two years' experience coordinating support for individuals with complex support needs including in particular AOD support needs co-occurring with serious mental health issues and other issues such as: trauma, homelessness, family and cultural separation or contact with the criminal justice system
- 4. Demonstrated experience working with young people with substance use disorder
- 5. Established networks and relationships with a range of services in the local area
- Strong administrative skills, computer literacy in MS Office and proficient use of technology such as databases, video conferencing and mobile devices
